

Thanks to everyone who has submitted the annual dues for 2024.

With that being said, I ask for members to promptly submit their dues for this year as well as past dues. As you are all aware, a portion (\$55) of each member's dues goes to the Grand Lodge of Virginia. Olive Branch is assessed this amount each year based on our active membership roster. Olive Branch pays the total assessment out of our operating fund regardless of the number of members who have paid their dues.

As of this date, only half of our members have paid their dues for 2024. Seven brothers owe more than one year. If you have not paid yet, you can bring in or send a check to the lodge or you can pay directly to the <u>Grand Lodge</u>. Dues are \$205 for the year plus any past dues.
